#### 2014 CATAMOUNT DIAMOND NOTES

#### RECAPPING WCU'S SoCon REGULAR SEASON CHAMPIONSHIP IN 2013:

- Western Carolina finished the 2013 season with 39 seasonal victories (39-20), the most under head coach Bobby Moranda ... WCU secured 30+ victories in a season for the 25th time since 1984 and the 10th time since 2000 ... the Catamounts were the first team in the SoCon to reach the 30-win plateau;
- The 2013 Catamount squad won 23 Southern Conference games, the MOST in program history ... the 23 victories surpassed the previous school-benchmark of 22 set back in the 2003 season ... WCU had 20-or-more SoCon wins for just the fifth time in school history;
- The Catamounts put together a school-record, 16-game win streak against SoCon foes
   the THIRD longest such streak in league history ... the Catamounts swept a school-best,
   FOUR-straight SoCon series including sweeps over Samford, Georgia Southern and Wofford at home, and taking all three at UNCG;
- WCU finished the home portion of its schedule with a 24-7 record, tied for the second-most victories in Childress Field /Hennon Stadium history and the most since the record-setting season in 2003 when the team won 25 home games ... It is the 10th time in facility history that WCU has recorded 20-or-more home wins
- WCU closed the regular season with a strong showing, winning 21 of its final 24 games from April 6th through May 18 ... the only non-conference losses during that stretch were to nationally-ranked Clemson ... the Catamounts won at least two games in NINE of their 10 Southern Conference series:
- Western Carolina hit 71 home runs as a team, the second-most among the 296 schools ranked ... WCU's 1.20 home runs (71 homers in 59 games) LED THE NATION in 2013 with the Catamounts deemed the national leader in home runs;
- Western Carolina landed seven players on the post-season All-Southern Conference team
  including league Player of the Year as selected by the voting media, senior Tyler White ...
  White was joined on the first team by shortstop Aaron Attaway, outfielder Julian Ridings and
  relief pitcher Preston Hatcher ... WCU also had second team selections catcher Adam Martin
  and starting pitcher Jeremy Null a two-time National Player of the Week selection with
  reliever Jonathan Waszak named to the all-freshman team.

#### NOTING THE 2014 WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS:

 Western Carolina returns seven of the nine hitters from a lineup that led the NCAA in home runs in 2013 with four returning players who hit .300-or-better a year ago. On the mound, the Catamounts bring back two-thirds of its weekend rotation with 23 of its 39 seasonal wins back. Additionally, WCU's pitching staff returns 65-percent of its 490 strikeouts (320) from 2013:

#### CATAMOUNTS TABBED 31ST IN COLLEGIATE BASEBALL PRESEASON POLL:

- Western Carolina was tabbed 31st in the national preseason poll as selected and released by Collegiate Baseball in late December, 2013 ... The Collegiate Baseball newspaper poll is the oldest college baseball poll dating back to the 1957 college baseball season;
- It is the first time the Catamounts have appeared among the preseason rankings from Collegiate Baseball since 2008 ... WCU appeared in the "Others Receiving Votes" section of the preseason poll in both 2006 and again prior to the 2008 season ... According to available research dating back to 1998, it also represents the highest preseason tabulation for the Purple & Gold.

#### ABOUT WESTERN CAROLINA'S 2014 BASEBALL SCHEDULE:

- Western Carolina's 2014 baseball schedule includes nine opponents that won 30-or-more
  games last spring ... the 56-game slate features a rigorous 27-game Southern Conference
  slate and five nonconference home-and-home mid-week series, as well as the second west
  coast trip in program history with a four-game set scheduled for Pullman, Wash., at Washington State;
- Four of WCU's 2014 opponents and a combined eight games come against teams that participated in last year's NCAA baseball championship tournament. Those foes include Clemson (March 4 & April 23), Georgia Tech (March 11), East Tennessee State (March 19 & 25), and SoCon tournament champion, Elon (March 21-23) on the road;
- Nine of the Catamounts' games are against teams from power NCAA conferences including four against WSU out of the Pac-12, four against the ACC and one meeting with SEC-foe, Georgia (March 9) in tournament action at Foley Field in Athens;
- The season opens in mid-February with three games against the Ohio Bobcats in Cullowhee and culminates with the 2013 Southern Conference Baseball Championship at Joseph P. Riley Park in Charleston, S.C., May 20-25 ... Four of WCU's nine SoCon tournament titles all-time have been won in Charleston.

### #2 AARON ATTAWAY /// SR., SS

- Attaway is coming off a season where he led the Southern Conference with 97 base hits – (the most by a Catamount since Brent Greer had a school-record 102 back in 2009) and 68 runs scored (the most by a WCU player since Blake Murphy scored 73 back in 2007);
- Attaway was a first-team All-Southern Conference selection in 2013 and garnered second team NCCSIA All-State plaudits ... Named to the ABCA All-Atlantic Region second team;
- Was listed on the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List (nation's top shortstop) and was a semifinalist for the 2013 Dick Howser Trophy (nation's top collegiate baseball player).

- Hoyle hit .310 in his sophomore season, collecting 29 extra base hits including 16 doubles to rank second on the team, two triples and 11 home runs – the third-most on the squad ... Legged out three doubles in a single-game against eventual Ohio Valley Conference (OVC) champion, Tennessee Tech;
