#### 2016 CATAMOUNT **DIAMOND NOTES**

#### RECAPPING THE 2015 SEASON:

- Western Carolina finished tied for sixth in the final 2015 SoCon regular season standings and was seeded seventh in the Southern Conference Baseball Championship ... WCU finished the year with an overall record of 21-30;
- WCU jumped on top of second-seeded Samford with a six-run first inning only to see the Bulldogs rally with two in the home half of the ninth to force extra innings, winning 8-7 in 10 frames in the SoCon tourney opener ... the Catamounts were later bounced from post-season play by sixth-seeded Furman, 12-4, in the weather-altered SoCon tournament;
- Senior Bradley Strong was a unanimous first team All-Southern Conference selection from both the coaches and voting media ... catcher Danny Bermudez earned All-SoCon second team honors from the coaches while Matt Smith was named second team All-SoCon by the media at the designated hitter position;
- Despite the losing record at the end of the season, WCU never dropped more than four-consecutive games during the 2015 campaign ... WCU's longest win streak was three games, coming in a three-game sweep of The Citadel in late March;
- For a second-consecutive year, Western Carolina was forced to play without the services of the SoCon's preseason player of the year due to a hand injury ... Two years ago, it was SS Aaron Attaway who was forced to the bench last season, it was hard-hitting slugger Jacob Hoyle who was sidelined .. Hoyle was only able to play in 14 games with 11 starts he did, however, bat .370 with six extra base hits including four home runs with a grand slam and drove in 15 RBI:
- Five Catamounts hit their first career home runs a season ago: Matt Smith belted his first career round-tripper in the season-opening win over Purdue ... Reece Strong hit his first homer on a solo shot at Liberty ... Jason Smith collected his first home run against Furman ... Pierce Suttles blasted two at ETSU including his first in a pinch hit role ... Spencer Holcomb hit his first of two home runs in the road series at Samford;
- WCU plated a school-record 15 runs in the bottom of the seventh inning of a 22-11 home win over Holy Cross ... the previous school benchmark was 14 accomplished the season prior against Rider at home.

#### NOTE ABOUT WCU HEAD COACH, BOBBY MORANDA:

WCU's eighth-year head coach Bobby Moranda finished the 2015 season with 253 career victories to rank third all-time in program history – just FOUR wins behind second-place Todd Raleigh (257, 2000-07) ... With 131 career Southern Conference wins, Moranda ranks second in WCU history behind Todd Raleigh (2000-07) who won 132 SoCon games at the head of the Catamount program.

#### NEW ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF FOR CATAMOUNT BASEBALL:

Moranda has a new staff entering the 2016 season ... He will be flanked by long-time Valdosta State assistant – and a former teammate at Eastern Kentucky – Todd Guilliams, and former head coach at NCAA Division II Gannon University, Nate Cocolin ... That trio is joined by volunteer assistant. Brock Doud:

#### WESTERN CAROLINA ENTERING THE 2016 SEASON:

- Western Carolina returns the bulk of its lineup a season ago, especially with numerous
  players being pressed into the lineup due to injuries in 2015 ... Notable losses include alltime triples leader, 2B Bradley Strong, and slugger Jacob Hoyle offensively ... Out of the
  bullpen, WCU lost RHP Tyler Powell, who finished his career tied for second in the program
  record book with 22 career saves in 97 career appearances;
- WCU returns 70-percent (107-of-152) extra base hits from a year ago including 74-of-97 doubles and 29 of its 46 home runs ... Despite losing seasonal-leader Bradley Strong's 58 RBI, the Catamounts return 227 of their 317 RBI from last season 71.6%;
- Though there may be a shake-up among the starting rotation in 2016, WCU returns four pitchers that started six-or-more games a year ago including its weekend rotation of LHP Bryan Sammons, RHP B.J. Nobles and RHP Korey Anderson ... WCU's pitching staff returns 88-percent of its strikeouts from last spring (375-of-426) including Nobles and Sammons, who finished 1-and-2 with 72 and 71 Ks, respectively;

#### ABOUT WESTERN CAROLINA'S 2016 BASEBALL SCHEDULE:

- Western Carolina's 2016 baseball schedule includes 22 home dates and 14 combined games against teams representing the Power Five conferences ... Three-game road series against Georgia Tech, Indiana, and Kansas State, road games at both North Carolina and Georgia, as well as home dates against Clemson and Virginia Tech headline the regular season calendar ... All told in nonconference play in 2016, the Catamounts will play seven games against the Atlantic Coast Conference, three apiece against the Big Ten, Big XII, and Mid-American Conference, and one against the American Athletic Conference;
- WCU's aggressive 55-game schedule opens with a three-game tournament at UNC Wilmington Feb. 19-21, and culminates with the annual Southern Conference Baseball Championship May 25-29, 2016 at Fluor Field at the West End in Greenville, S.C.



#### #2 KRAMER FERRELL /// SR., OF

- Was one of four Catamounts to start all 51 games a year ago including 47 starts in right field and four in center ... Batted .295 collectively with 57 hits including 10 doubles, a triple and six home runs ... Recorded 32 RBI;
- Was third on the Catamount squad with 19 multiple hit games while also posting five multi-RBI outings in his first season for the Purple & Gold;
- Played in the California Collegiate League during the summer of 2015, claiming player of the game honors three times.



#### #5 BRETT POPE /// SOPH., INF

- Started all 51 games a year ago as a true freshman including 11 of his first 13 at third base before a combined 40 at shortstop in place of the injured J.D. Long ... Had six doubles and drove in 22 on the season, adding 14 stolen bases in 18 seasonal attempts ... Led the Catamounts with 14 sacrifice hits ... Was part of turning 17 double plays at shortstop;
- Opened his Western Carolina career with an impressive 5-for-5 showing at the plate with a double and four runs scored in the 2015 season-opener against Purdue;
- Played both in the Valley (Charlottesville) and the Northwoods (St. Cloud) Leagues during the summer



#### #16 COLTON DAVIS /// SR., RHP

- Solid set-up man on the back-end of the Catamount bullpen who battled through injury in 2015, making 18 appearances including 15 out of the pen and three starts ... Tossed 28.0 innings with 34 strikeouts against 25 walks ... Held opponents scoreless in seven of his 18 appearances on the year;
- Spent part of the summer pitching in the New England Baseball League for eventual league champion, the Vermont Mountaineers ... Made six relief appearances, posting a 2-0 record and a gleaming 0.93 ERA.
